

II. EDUCATION AND YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

1. «TWONGERE UBUMENYI» PROJECT

TRIP contributes in education through « TWONGERE UBUMENYI » PROJECT by preparing reading tests to the primary school students in order to support them improving their reading thinking readiness. TRIP also teaches young girls and boys about hygiene and sanitation, reproductive health and sex education to avoid any kind of sexual abuse and being active in gender mainstreaming in families. In addition a TV was put at their disposition to allow them learning various information and cultures as well as having fun.

2. SPONSORSHIP

TRIP collaborates with different stakeholders to collect funds to pay for school fees for children from vulnerable families, paying their school materials and to provide different trainings during holidays.



3. REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH AND SEX EDUCATION PROJECT

This project aims at training young people to manage their health and future responsibly. Through this project, different trainings about reproductive health and sex education are provided to youth PEACE EDUCATION AND HUMAN RIGHTS PROGRAM

A. TRIP LEGAL PERSONALITY

TRIP was granted the Operational Certificate of Legal Personality N0 907/RGB/NGO/LP/06/2023 on 21 June 2023 by RGB.

B. TRIP PROGRAMMES:

TRIP carries out its main projects through three programs (agriculture and food security, Education and youth development, peace education and human rights)

I. AGRICULTURE AND FOOD SECURITY PROGRAM

1. TWUNGE UBUMWE PROJECT

TRIP “TWUNGUBUMWE” PROJECT aims to promote and support the community to participate, working together, team spirit, social responsibility and accountability through

various groups and associations of VSLGs commonly called “TRIP Stakeholders”. This project brings community members together in various activities for a sufficient production for everyone on a rotation basis.

2. “TWITEZE IMBERE MU BWOROZI BW’INGURUBE” PROJECT

TRIP donates piglets to rural people through Stakeholders. Those piglets also become a source of piglets to spread to others in surrounding populations. The initiative would improve their level of social and economic well-being.



TRIP also provides a technical support to the beneficiaries of piglets on how to practice modern farming

3. “TWOZANYE INKA” PROJECT

To contribute in poverty eradication, through « TWOZANYE INKA » PROJECT, TRIP lends cows to poor families on temporary and rotation basis (« Kuragiza concept ») until the process allows a beneficiary to own a cow. Those cows help rural people in fighting against malnutrition, in social cohesion and in social economic development. TRIP has just lent 34 cows to those in need.

4. “TWITEZE IMBERE MU BUHINZI” PROJECT

Through « TWITEZIMBERE MU BUHINZI » project, TRIP supports rural people to find modern seeds of crops and builds their capacity in modern agriculture for a sustainable production, especially in bananas, avocados and chayote to fight both malnutrition and soil erosion. Kitchen gardens, IGA, High Labor Intensity.



5. TUNOZE UMWUGA PROJECT

TRIP provides major professional trainings in various domains and learning trips as far as socioeconomic matters especially in modern agriculture and livestock farming and in education rights and obligations. TRIP initiated a pedagogical farm and Farmer Field Schools. TRIP hires expert farmers to train TRIP stakeholders farmers about modern farming of pigs, cows, bees, hens and bananas’ agriculture, etc...

The beneficiaries are assisted with study trips for knowledge exchange

6. KABUSHINGE GREEN PROJECT

This project consists of rehabilitating and planting new forests. TRIP has just supported beneficiaries to plant 14.000 eucalyptus, 500 avocado trees and 3.500 greveria in Kabushinge cell.
